

PILOT SCHOLARSHIP HOUSE FOUNDATION

Pilot Scholarship Foundation is a project of the Florida District of Pilot International. Our District has built and paid for 3 scholarship houses in Florida at three different colleges, Florida State University in Tallahassee, University of Florida in Gainesville and Florida Gulf Coast University in Ft. Myers. These three houses have a total of 61 girls residing in a cooperative living arrangement. The girls manage these houses themselves.

Members of Pilot Clubs in Florida support these houses through fund raisers at our 2 annual conventions and through memorial and donations. Individual Pilot clubs support this project by contributing to the houses with gift cards and requested items.

Southern Scholarship Foundation has applications for residency on their web site. Each application is judged on financial need, high academic promise, and a high level of motivation, outstanding character, integrity and citizenship. It is also based on recommendations by school officials and community leaders and each girl's willingness to share in the household duties and responsibilities. Southern Scholarship Foundation is also responsible, through our Foundation, for the maintenance of each house.
